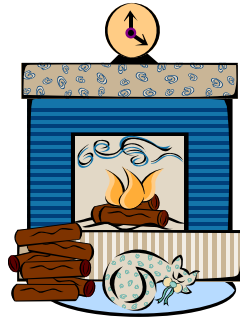


Fuel Assistance Programs



If you are concerned about heating costs this winter, you may be eligible for assistance from one of these programs:

- ❁ **Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIEAP)**, a Federal program, provides money to help low-income homeowners and renters pay for heating costs. York County Community Action handles these applications. FMI- call 207-324-5762.
- ❁ **Citizens Energy Oil Heat Program**, Joe Kennedy's program, in partnership with CITGO, works with oil heat dealers and local fuel assistance agencies to provide deliveries of home heating oil to struggling families. FMI - call 617-338-6300.
- ❁ **Town of Kennebunkport Emergency Fuel Program**, provides fuel assistance to Kennebunkport residents in need. Money for this program is funded through donations. The General Assistance Administrator, Judy Barrett, handles these applications. FMI- on the numerous fuel/weatherization programs available, contact Ms. Barrett at 207-967-4401.
